In the Museum, I See...

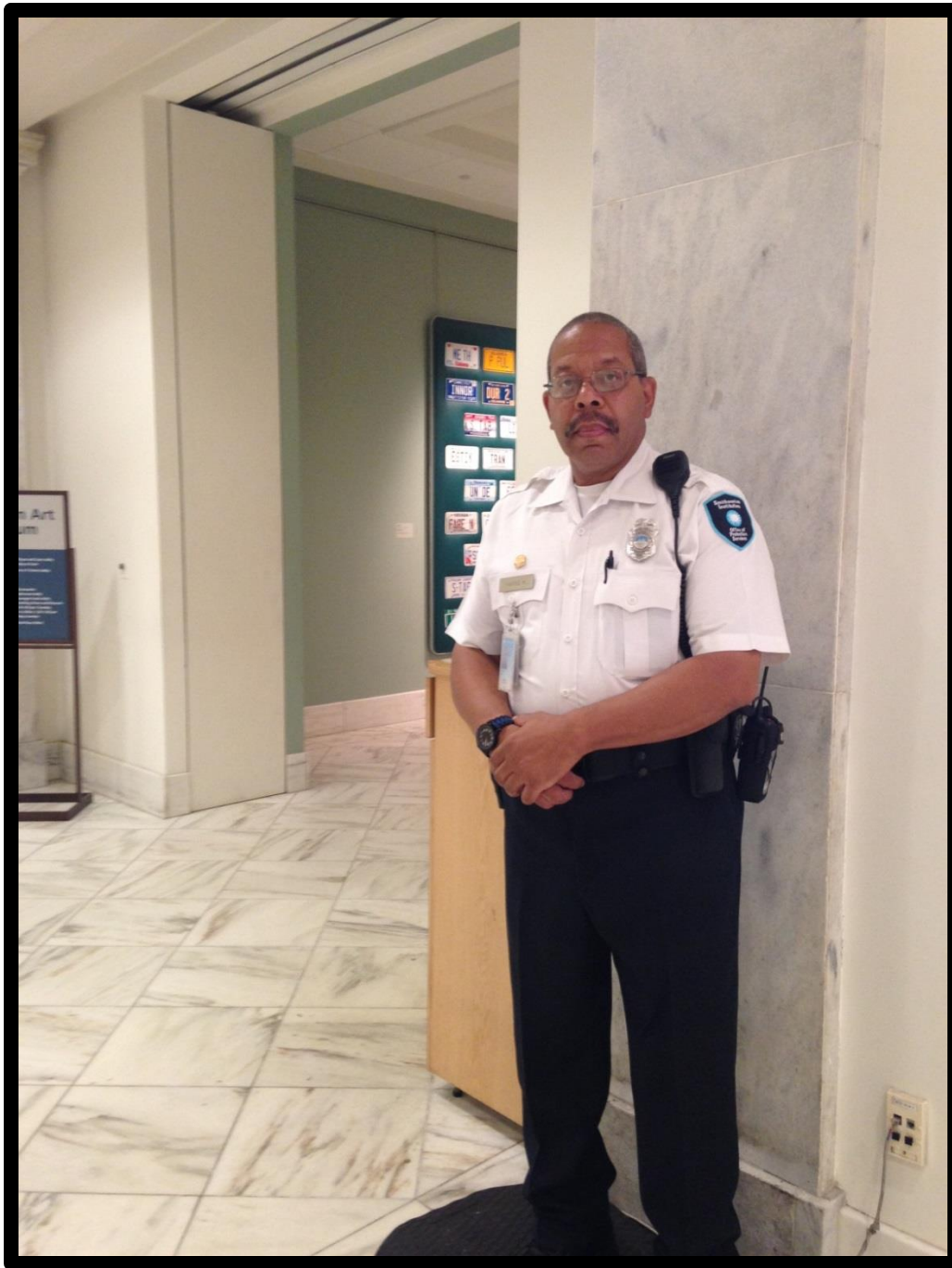
I am going to a museum. The museum is called the National Portrait Gallery. It is a big building with lots of art.

I may see security guards in the museum. Security guards keep me safe.

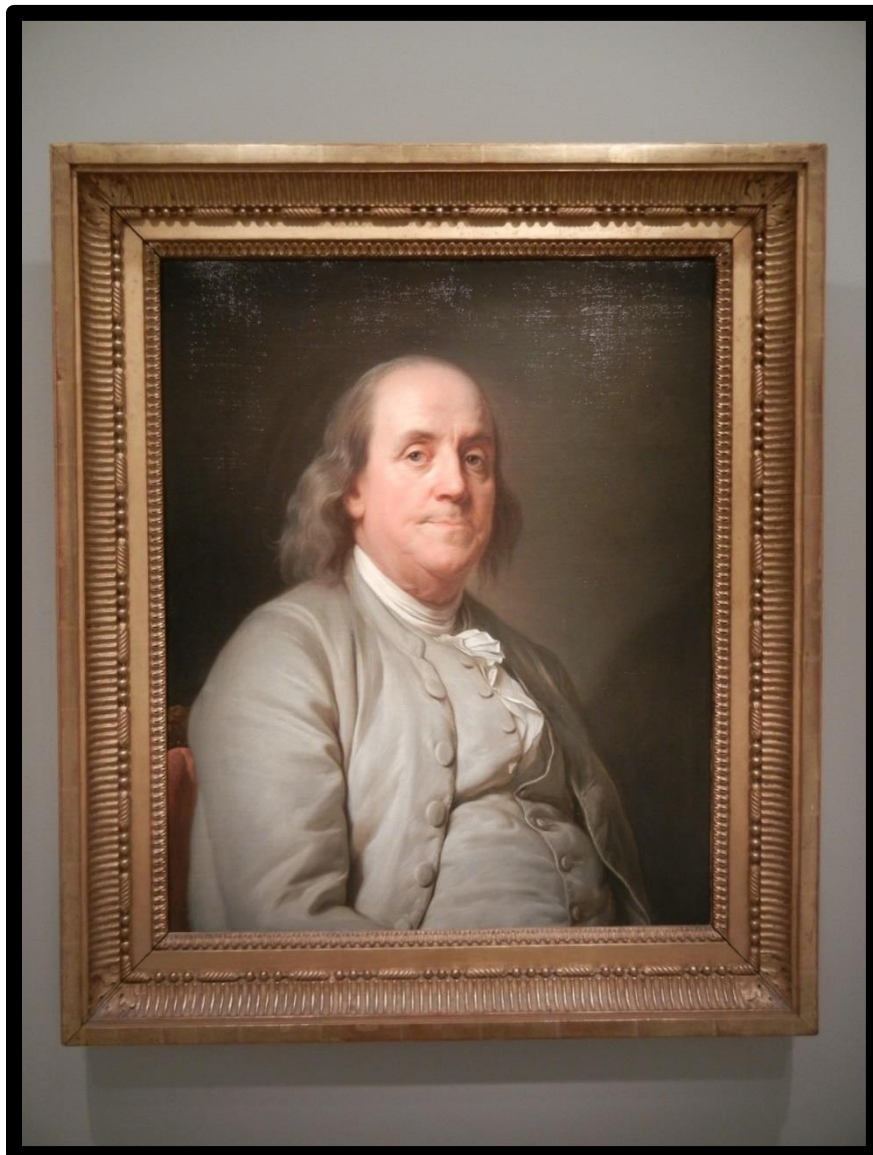


**I may see signs in the museum.
